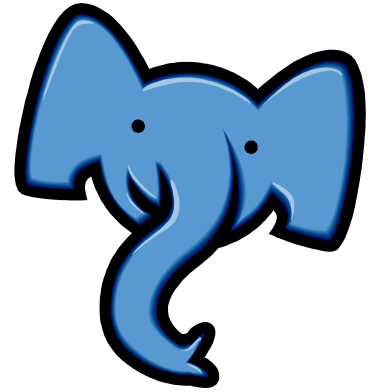

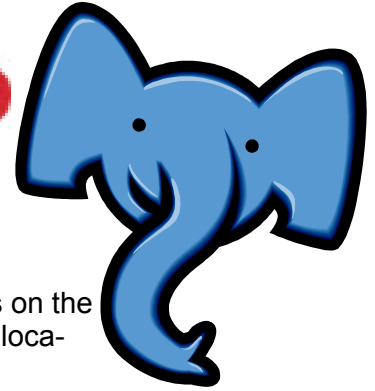

Concealed Carry Anniversary Raffle

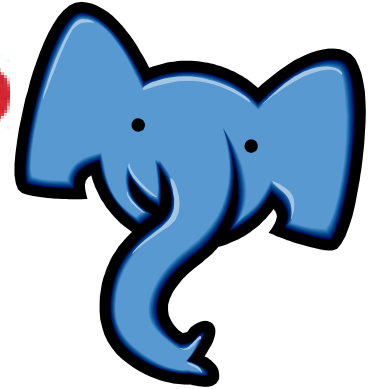
Buy Your Tickets Now!

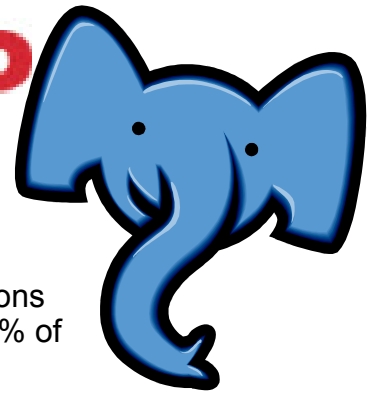

We must work together to protect the precious freedoms that are the foundation of our government. Ronald Reagan's words continue to ring true today.

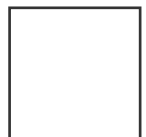
