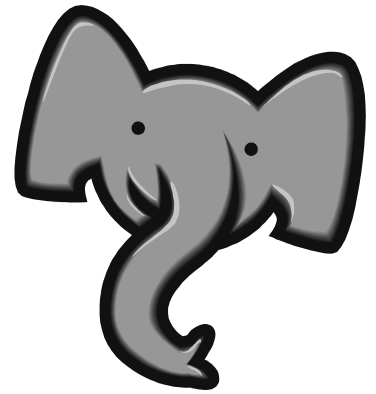

# GLENN GROTHMAN

*Conservative for Congress*



Glenn Grothman has proven his effective, conservative leadership throughout his time in the State Legislature. He has served in the State Senate since 2004 and is the current Assistant Majority Leader. He also served in the State Assembly since 1994. Before entering into public service, Glenn worked in the private sector as an attorney specializing in estate and tax law.
