

Manitowoc Public School District School Referenda

The first question asks for \$1million in RECURRING revenue limit capacity to maintain current programs and services.

The second question asks for \$600,000 in RECURRING revenue capacity to address maintenance and security needs.

The third question asks for \$400,000 in additional RECURRING revenue to upgrade classroom technology.

Voting "yes" means the taxpayers give the school budget an addition \$2 million dollars IN PERPETUITY. The school district says this will cost taxpayers with property valued at \$100,000 an additional \$1.48 a week. Of course, the school district reduces it to the smallest sum to look miniscule. That \$1.48 a week equals a \$77.00 increase for the year and there is no way to know how much this will increase "in perpetuity."

The school district claims the referenda are necessary due to a \$5 million reduction in state aid. The convenient omission is that \$5 million INCLUDES the money the state is no longer contributing to teachers' health insurance and pension plans

Unlike the county government, the Manitowoc Public School District (MPSD) has not taken advantage of Act 10. It has done little to hold down the cost of sick leaves or even the cost of insurance. It could ask teachers' spouses with insurance to claim the teacher on their insurance. Because our county government has held down costs, this makes it easier for the school district to ask for more and raise taxes.

Perhaps the biggest insult to taxpayers is the fact it spent precious tax dollars to hire consultants to lend a patina of legitimacy to what the school board wants to do.

One of its KEY FACTS states MPSD ranks in the bottom 20% of districts in the state in spending per student. Great!!!! Keep up the good work! It says it is doing a great job with our students yet complaining because it doesn't have enough funding and staff -- that seems very contradictory.


