

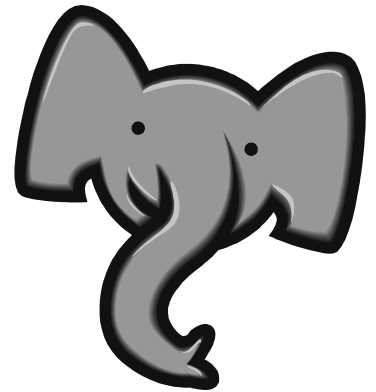

Manitowoc Public School District Referenda

The first question requests \$1million in RECURRING revenue limit capacity to maintain current programs and services.

The second question requests \$600,000 in RECURRING revenue capacity to address maintenance and security needs.

The third question requests \$400,000 in additional RECURRING revenue to upgrade classroom technology.

The school district says this will cost taxpayers with property valued at \$100,000 an additional \$1.48 a week. Of course, the school district reduces it to the smallest sum to look miniscule. That \$1.48 a week equals a \$77.00 annual increase and there is no way to know how much this will increase "in perpetuity." Superintendent Marcia Flaherty admitted at an informational meeting she did not foresee MPSD not needing the annual \$2M.

The terms "recurring" and "in perpetuity" mean a yes vote gives the school district \$2M spending authority EVERY YEAR FOR AN INFINITE PERIOD OF TIME. The school district claims the referenda are necessary due to a reduction in state aid. MPSD blames Governor Walker but so-called "pro education" President Obama reduced federal aid to the school district by a much larger percentage. Ironic, isn't it?

Perhaps the biggest insult to taxpayers is the fact it spent approximately \$70k of our tax dollars to hire consultants to lend a patina of legitimacy to what the school board wants to do.

One of its KEY FACTS states MPSD ranks in the bottom 20% of Wisconsin school districts in spending per student. Great!!!! Keep up the good work! It says it is doing a great job with our students yet complains because it doesn't have enough funding and staff -- further evidence MPSD has never had a definite plan to address its cash flow problem and that is has no idea how much money is needed for its alleged needs.

Call school board members, ask questions, do your homework, talk to friends, family and neighbors. We are finally pulling out of our tax mire. We need MPSD to roll up its sleeves and find ways to cut spending. VOTE NO on this brazen tax grab.

How to Report Election Fraud

You will have to file a complaint online at <http://gab.wi.gov/feedback/complaints>
You may also telephone the GAB at 1-800-947-3529 to report election fraud or voter intimidation.

Election Observer Guidelines

- ◆ Notify the chief election inspector you are there to observe
- ◆ Follow the directives of the chief election inspector or designee
- ◆ Provide photo ID
- ◆ Complete and sign an election observer log
- ◆ Wear an election observer tag or badge

Election Observers May NOT

- ◆ Engage in activity intended to influence voting
- ◆ Video and cameras are not allowed in polling areas
- ◆ Handle official election documents
- ◆ Make phone calls. Texting is acceptable only if not disruptive
- ◆ Interact with voters, except when requested
- ◆ View confidential information on the poll list or take photos/make copies of the poll list on Election Day



Checks written to the Manitowoc GOP must be drawn on a PERSONAL, not corporate account. Checks may also NOT be drawn on trust accounts. Federal and state election laws require this. Please address questions to Jeff Dewane, treasurer, at jdewane1@gmail.com.
